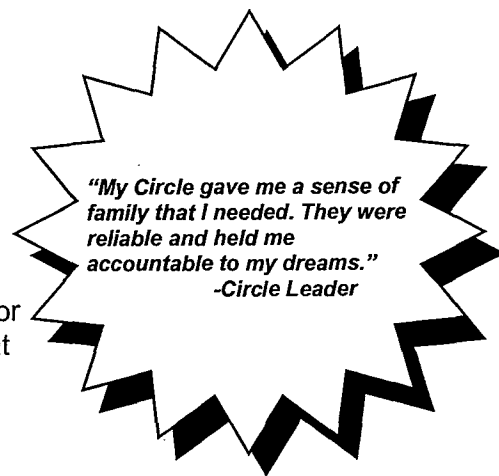
All individuals and families have the capability to be financially stable given the appropriate resources. The question is then, "How can we reach this plateau of financial independence in today's economy?"
